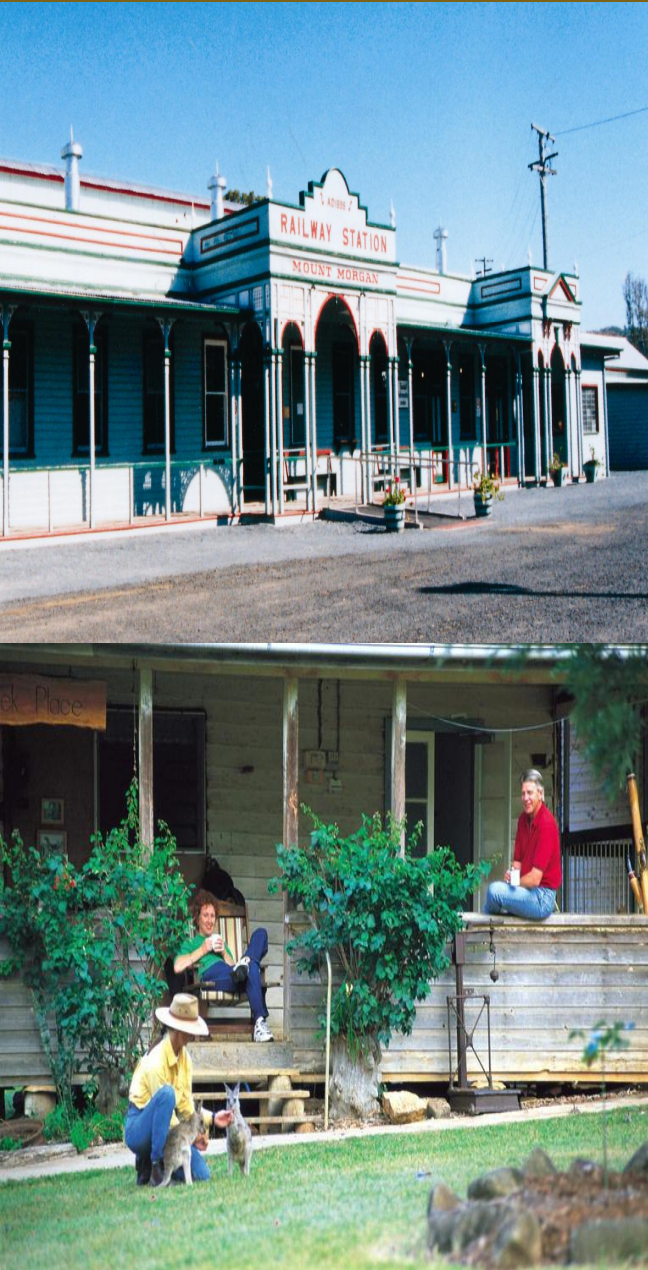


Self drive tours Capricorn Queensland

Rockhampton to Mt Morgan & Myella

Tropic of Capricorn Spire

Rockhampton straddles the Tropic of Capricorn, and the spire marks the spot where you leave the temperate zone and enter the tropics. It provides a great photo opportunity and the visitor information centre, located just behind the Spire, offers a certificate of your visit.

Mt Morgan

30 minute drive from the Spire
Take the scenic drive up the range and visit and discover the one of the world's richest gold mines. In its hey-day, Mt Morgan was an integral part of our region's history. Mined for nearly 100 years, the city's mine sites yielded 247,000kg of gold, 40,000kg of silver and 360,000 tonnes of copper.

Mt Morgan Railway Station

5 min drive from city centre
While in the town you can visit the Mt Morgan Railway Station, which was established in 1898 and continued operating for 90 years. Today it is a tourist information centre and the site for monthly markets which attract stall holders and exhibitors from throughout the area.

Historical Museum

5 minute drive from Rail Station
The historic museum has a collection of memorabilia which gives an insight to the early years of this mining town. There are also hundreds of photographs on hand which depict the boom and bust periods the people of Mt Morgan have experienced. Visitors can view the mine and Tipperary Point, then on to the swinging bridge, one of only **two** remaining in this state.

Myella Farm Stay

1hr drive from Mt Morgan
Travel along the Burnett Highway past the township of Wowan (Known for its large cattle stations) towards Baralaba and the Myella station.

Once you arrive at Myella you are in for a treat, horse riding, Milking cows, star gazing and campfires are all part of the experience.
